IN VIEW OF TODAY, APRIL 15TH

In the VAST Sea of a trillion (or more) fish and other living creatures, Jesus (God) has 'APPOINTED' a certain fish to be the tool of provision for something as ominous as a TAX that wasn't even really due. Why did Jesus go to such lengths to pay an unfair tax, a fishy tax?...."so that we do not offend them..." Jesus does everything from LOVE. If it's not driven by love, it's not driven by Jesus...hummm. Now let's talk about appointments.

A p p o i n t m e n t s :

This 'fishy tax' reminds me of the story of Jonah where God 'appoints' a fish to swallow Jonah (Jon.1:17); After God commanded the fish to spit Jonah out on dry land, and Jonah preaches to Ninevah, then God 'appointed a 'plant' to grow to give Jonah shade (4:6); God



then 'appoints' a worm to eat the plant (4:7); God appointed a scorching east wind (4:8), etc., and all of this proving that God is both really big and also intimately involved in all the little details to provide for His people and for His plans. GOD IS TOTALLY AND UTTERLY IN CONTROL! From the details to the big picture, our Awesome God has it all in His hands! We really have nothing to fear and nothing to worry about if we take a lesson from what God has already done in His Word. We can trust Him in ALL of it....

How incredibly awesome is God? How detailed, and sovereign is the ONE Whose hand we rest in? Take heart today that we serve a GOD who sees, Who knows, and Who CAN meet all of our needs in supernatural ways if need be...Let's trust Him today, this tax day, to provide for all of our needs according to His riches in Glory in Christ Jesus!
